OVERVIEW

In gratitude for your invaluable role in the clinical development of our APRN students, we want to offer you the opportunity to be appointed as an adjunct clinical affiliate!

Appointments as adjunct clinical affiliates are part-time, on an annual basis, and without tenure.

These appointments are subject to the Dean's approval and are designed to recognize preceptor's commitment to the education of our students.

PROCESS

Preceptors for APRN students who wish to be considered for a zero-funded Adjunct Clinical Affiliate appointment should contact their program director by **July 1** for fall appointments and **November 1** for spring appointments.

Interested individuals should include a current copy of their résumé or CV, along with a brief description of their service to the school.

If approved by the Dean, you will be notified by email.

REQUIREMENTS

- Service to the School of Nursing for at least two semesters as preceptor
- Willingness to continue to serve as a preceptor over the next year
- Certification or licensure in a particular area of expertise
- Clinical excellence and serve as positive role model
- Support the mission and goals of UT Austin School of Nursing
