

Visiting Scholars Program

The University of Texas at Austin School of Nursing and the Center for Global Nursing and Health welcome applications from visiting scholars from around the world and across the U.S. The visiting scholar program enhances and accelerates research within the field of nursing and provides opportunities for cross cultural exchange and collaboration.

- Open to tenured and tenure-track faculty
- Interested scholars should complete a general inquiry form at nursing.utexas.edu/cgcn
- Applicants should begin the application process at least six months in advance of their anticipated arrival date—12 months in advance is preferred.
- Program cost: \$10,000 for 12 months. The minimum length of stay is one month, and the maximum length of stay is one year. Stays of less than 12 months will be pro-rated.
- Program cost does not include living expenses such as housing or meals. Scholars will have free access to the city and university bus systems with a UT ID card.
