- Applicants MUST have completed a minimum of 5 prerequisite courses by December 31st including: Human Anatomy and Microbiology (+).
- Applicants MUST have completed Human Anatomy, Human Physiology and Pharmacology within 6 years from the anticipated AE program enrollment date (*).
- If admitted, all 7 prerequisite courses must be complete before ENROLLING in the AE program
- Applicants choosing to retake a prerequisite because of low grades, during admissions, and are subsequently admitted are unable to use the lower grade course to meet the prerequisite. A transcript showing the new course grade is required.
- All prerequisite courses are subject to approval by the Graduate Student Services Office.
